## Tips for using the Embroidery Machine

### Specific to this Brother SE400 Embroidery Machine:

- If using your own design it must be a .PES file which is the format Brother uses.
- This machine has the ability to embroider designs up to 4" x 4".
- It is recommended that you read through the Embroidery section of the Manual before using the machine to familiarize yourself with it first.

### General Embroidery Machine Tips:

- Learning to use an embroidery machine takes time. Be patient and be ready to practice!
- Avoid problems by taking the time to test stitch designs on similar fabric before embroidering the final piece.  
There are a lot of variables in play when using an Embroidery machine. The stitch may turn out differently depending on digitizer, stabilizer, fabric, needles, and thread used. Design files can become corrupted during download or during conversion.
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
