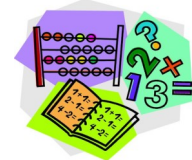


Screen Free Project for Elementary School



Spring Blossoms



Instructions:

- Step 1:** On a piece of construction paper, draw and cut out a tree without leaves. Glue your tree to a white piece of paper. (If you don't have construction paper at home, you can use a white piece of paper and draw out your tree trunk with a crayon or marker)
- Step 2:** Cut tissue paper into 15-20 1.5 inch squares. (Recommended colors: green, white, pink)
- Step 3:** Put a small dot of glue on a branch of your tree. Lay one piece of tissue paper on a flat surface, and hold a pencil with the eraser side down at the center of the tissue paper. Pull all corners of the tissue paper up and scrunch them around the pencil. Pick up pencil while holding the tissue paper in place, and push down on the dot of glue. You've created your first blossom!
- Step 4:** Repeat, add as many tissue paper blossoms as you desire. Change up the color of the tissue paper to add color and creativity to your tree. Use crayons to draw a background, or add any more creative
